

Home Inspection – Buyer Preparation

- 1) Hire a Certified Home Inspector can provide you with a current list of the best inspectors in town. But even so, it's a good idea to look into them and decide on the best one for you!
- 2) Be present during the inspector
 Being present during the home inspection will ensure you can go over any findings in real time, as well as learning how the home operates, location of important controls, etc. The inspector can also inform you of maintenance items, etc.
- 3) Prepare questions
